All commercial property, and businesses are to have an annual fire inspection. The owner and/or occupants are responsible for any and all fees/fines associated with these inspections. Please allow 7-9 business days for scheduling all inspections.

If any work is done to any fire protection system and/or alarm system the owner and/or contractor must have the system re-inspected prior to the system being placed back in service. If one or more violations are found during the initial inspection a re-inspection will be scheduled for a later date. If the violations are not corrected at time of initial re-inspection, additional inspections will be charged the re-inspection fee.
